AGS Membership & Achievement Awards

The Alberta Genealogical Society's members possess the passion to achieve some amazing tasks noted by the genealogical community across Canada and around the world. Recognition is defined as "acknowledgment or admission of a service, achievement or ability". Achievement means 'something that has been done or achieved through effort: a result of hard work'.

Below are categories of accomplishment and achievement for which members may be recognized with an award.

LIFE MEMBERSHIP:

May be granted by the Board to members of the Society who have rendered long and distinguished service to the Society.

HONOURARY MEMBERSHIP:

May be granted by the Board to non-members who have contributed to or performed extremely beneficial service for the Society. There are no privileges of membership included with this honour except that attendance at meetings, without voting rights, is welcomed.

PRESIDENT'S AWARD:

May be granted by the President for outstanding achievement by an AGS member for the year; or it may be given to an AGS branch that has celebrated twenty or more years of service. This award may be given in the absence of nominations, however is only given once to a recipient.

SPECIAL MENTION:

An award given by the AGS Executive to a member or non-member who has assisted AGS in reaching its objectives. Flexible in scope and criteria, the award may be a certificate or a special gift suitable to the occasion.

LONG TERM MEMBERSHIP:

This award is given for twenty-five (25) accumulated years of loyal membership to the Society. It is given primarily on the merit for consistency and the dedicated pursuit of genealogical research and family history.
