A lifelong dream became a reality for me in September 2016 with the opportunity to visit the ancestral villages of my paternal grandparents in Poland and Ukraine. From childhood, I have always had an interest in the 'old country', when I first started questioning my Grandfather. However, information was not readily forthcoming and I was lacking in the necessary interviewing skills at the time.

### **Preliminary Research**

In 2001, I was welcomed into the Grande Prairie & District Branch of AGS and my 'genealogical' journey began. The other big influence was my becoming a member of the East European Genealogy Society in Winnipeg. This organization's focus was exactly in the places that reinforced and fine-tuned my quest. I came to learn very soon that I had overestimated the depth and completeness of my work and welcomed more than a little assistance from my travelling companions. Brian Lenius, charter member of East European Genealogy Society, was to be our organizer and guide for trip, as he had experience in finalizing research and organizing trips for others.
