As a result, those of us who presently hold positions on the Executive have decided to continue for the 2019/2020 term, with the following tentative changes:

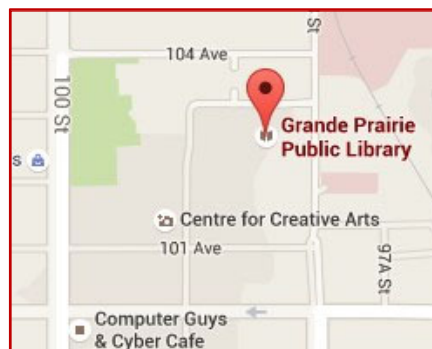
- 1) Reduce the number of Meetings:
