

ANCESTRY.COM, LIBRARY EDITION WETASKIWIN PUBLIC LIBRARY

START:

- Connect to the library Wifi - if using your own laptop/tablet/phone, etc. choose the option that is shown as Wetaskiwin_Public_Library
- Connect to the Search Engine you prefer to use - most people use Google
- Type in the URL: wetaskiwinpubliclibrary.ab.ca
- Log in with your library membership number and your pass-word
- On this page, lower right side of the page - click on “ancestry library edition”

INFORMATION:

- The Library Edition of Ancestry allows you to search the data-bases
- If using the library’s computers you can print documents and information, using the library’s printer
- You cannot set up a personal account using the Library Edition
- If using your own device, you can:
 - a) save the data to a flash drive, and
 - b) email the information you have discovered to your own personal email address
- Already have a tree on Ancestry?
 - You can’t access your tree if you are using the Library Edition of Ancestry.

SEARCH POSSIBILITIES:

- General search on Ancestry
- Become familiar with the collections available on Ancestry
- It can be much faster and more accurate searching a collection you know your family is in than just a general search
- **BE SURE THE RECORD YOU FIND IS REALLY THE PERSON YOU’RE RELATED TO BEFORE YOU ATTACH IT TO ANYONE**
