A Depression Glass cake plate draw was sponsored during the tea. The draw will take place at the Collectibles Sale on April 19. Depression Glass was made in the period 1929-1939. It was often clear or coloured translucent glassware distributed free or at low cost at the time of the "Great Depression". The pieces were used as giveaways to persuade customers to purchase goods. Pink glass is the most valuable.
